- Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate.
- Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information Bulletin on counselling board website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified
- Candidates must ensure that e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own as all information/ communication will be sent by counselling board through e-mail on e-mail address or SMS on given Mobile Number only

  - ❖ Download Information Bulletin and Replica of Application Form. Read these carefully to ensure your eligibility.
  - ❖ Follow the 4 steps given below to Apply Online:
    - Step-1:** Fill in the Online Application Form and note down the system generated Application No.
    - Step-2:** Upload scanned images of Candidate’s Photograph in JPG/JPEG format.
    - Step-3:** Make payment of fee using appropriate payment mode through appropriate payment gateway and keep proof of fee paid.

**Note:-**

1. The final submission of Online Application Form will remain incomplete if Step-2 and step-3 are not completed. Such forms will stand rejected and no correspondence on this account will be entertained.
2. No request for refund of fee once remitted by the candidate will be entertained by counselling board under any circumstances.
3. The entire application process of PG counselling is online, including uploading of scanned images, Payment of Fees, and Printing of Confirmation Page. Therefore, candidates are not required to send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation Page to Counselling Board through Post/ Fax/ by Hand.
4. Candidates are advised to keep visiting the Counselling Board website regularly for latest updates and to check their e-mails.

**2. Registration Fee:** All candidates are required to deposit registration fee of Rs. **2000/-** (for General & OBC candidates) and Rs. **1200/-** (for SC/ ST candidate of Rajasthan state domicile + applicable e-mitra charges through Internet banking / Debit card / Credit card or at any E-Mitra CSC Kiosk Centre (authorized by the Government of Rajasthan). The registration fee is neither refundable, nor transferable and nor adjustable for any future State PG admissions. Any plea in this matter shall not be entertained. Please keep the information submitted in application form confidential and do not share with anybody. If you don't register during registration period, you will not be allotted any seat. Please also note that registration will be available once only.

**3.** AIAPGET-2019 qualified candidates may apply for counselling and admission to Ayurved PG Institutions in Rajasthan, if eligible based on applicable rules, regulations, reservation policy and other criteria specified by Govt. of India/ Govt. of Rajasthan respectively.

**4.** Admission Board will propose its own merit list considering AIAPGET-2019 merit list and based on its applicable rules regulations, reservation policy and other criteria.

**5.** Counselling will be conducted by Admission Counselling Board based on merit list of registered eligible applicants as per rules on scheduled dates which will be displayed at website/ informed by SMS/website, at Dr. SR Rajasthan Ayurved University's main campus at Karwar, Jodhpur and offer of admission will be made to the meritorious candidates as per rules and basis of counselling etc.

## **6 General Instructions, Terms and Conditions**

- Applicants may kindly note that appearance in PG Counselling 2019 does not confer any automatic rights to secure an AYUSH Post Graduate MD / MS seat. The selection and admission to Postgraduate seats in any AYUSH institution(s) recognized for running MD / MS courses as per the CCIM Act is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, medical fitness and other criteria as may be prescribed by the respective universities, AYUSH institutions, CCIM, State/Central Government
- Online Registration begins on 02 September 2019 and must be completed by 11 September 2019 by 11.50PM.
- Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered and such candidates may be debarred from appearing in any future counselling conducted by counselling board.
- Before initiating registration process, candidates should go through the Information Bulletin carefully for eligibility criteria, scheme and pattern of examination etc. Any queries and other issues will only be entertained if the requested information is not given in the Information Bulletin.
- Incomplete application, if not in accordance with instructions, will not be considered and is liable to be rejected. Applicant should carefully fill up all the fields during registration process. Application cannot be modified/edited at any circumstances.
- The registration fee will neither be refunded nor be carried forward under any circumstances.
- Instructions in the Information-Bulletin are liable to change based on decisions taken by the Constitutional Authorities.
- Counselling board reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in PG Counselling even though Registration number has been issued or is displayed on website

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ADMISSION IN PART-I OF AYURVEDA VACHASPATI/ DHANWANTARI – MD/MS (AY.) FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-20**

### **1.0. COMMON FEATURES**

#### **1.1 Qualification for Admission:**

**1.1** Ayurvedacharya Degree (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery) of Universities of Rajasthan State OR any equivalent Degree recognized by CCIM.

**1.2.** (A) Only those students who have qualified in the AIPGET-2019 can participate in the counselling for admission in AYUSH PG courses for the academic year 2019-20.

(B) Minimum qualifying marks for AIPGET-2019 will be as specified in existing PG Regulation (ASU) as given below:

“The qualifying criteria for AYUSH MD/MS/ courses shall be as per CCIM and Ministry of AYUSH, Govt of India directions i.e. Indian Medicine Central council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Amendment Regulation 2018, In order to be eligible for admission to post-graduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the AIAPGET 2019. Qualifying criteria for candidates belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile. Candidate with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities act, 2016 (49 fo 2016) the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for General category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for scheduled caste, scheduled tribes and other backward classes.”

**1.3. Candidates:** Must have completed the six or twelve months rotating Internship/House Job, as the case may be, after passing the qualifying examination **by 31 Oct. 2019 or as decided by The Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.**

**1.4.** The online application form and prospectus will be available on the Board website [www.rajugpgayushcounselling.in](http://www.rajugpgayushcounselling.in) from 02.09.2019 to 11.09.2019

#### **1.5. Admission Procedure:**

- i. Admission will be subject to the rules & regulation of the respective institutes.
- ii. Admission Counselling Board reserves the right to correct any inadvertent error in any merit list and also in the prospectus.
- iii. The Admission Counselling Board shall organize counselling of the candidates and allot the Institute and Subjects taking into an account the Scheme of distribution of reserved seats, Merit lists of respective categories, the order of the Merit of AIAPGET 2019, Preference and Availability of seats.
- iv. The right of admission of any candidate who does not complete the prescribed internship by **31 Oct. 2019 or as decided by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India** will automatically stand cancelled.
- v. Vacancies arising due to any reason shall be filled by reshuffling on the Basis of Reservations and Merit-cum-Preference List from the candidates in the Waiting Lists (Except Central/ Rajasthan Govt. Candidates).
- vi. No TA/D.A. will be paid to the candidates for appearing in the Counselling.

### **Selection of Candidates for Admission**

Selection of the candidates for Admission shall be made by the Counselling Board. Selection of the candidates shall be made strictly on the basis of AIAPGET-2019 Merit.

## 1.6 Counselling, Merit List, Subject Preference and Allotment:

- i. The candidates will be called for counselling according to Provisional Merit List.
- ii. For rest of the Categories, subjects shall be allotted according to Reservations, Merit in the respective Subjects, Preference, Availability of seats etc.
- iii. For equal marks in AIAPGET-2019, the final merit will be decided at the time of counselling by BAMS original Marks-sheet, therefore candidate must fill-up his BAMS marks in application form. In case there is tie of the marks in AIAPGET-2019 merit list preference will be given to the candidate passing B.A.M.S. examination in first attempt in the higher percentage of the marks. If a tie still exists, the allotment shall be made giving preference to seniority in age.
- iv. The selected candidates must carry all requisite certificates / documents in original along with self-attested copies of the same for verification, at the time of reporting to Counselling Board along with demand draft of the **Non-refundable** token fees of Rs. 20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand) in favour of "**Chairman, AYUSH UG Counselling Admission Board, Rajasthan**" payable at Jodhpur to be submitted to Counselling Board, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled.
- vi. The Actual Admissions in a particular Institute will be subject to the rules and regulations of that Institute.

## 2. Reservations, Subjects and Admission Capacity:

Subjects, Reservations & Admission Capacity are different in different Institutes. The distribution of seats in a particular institute will be as per the rules & regulations of the respective Institution and State Govt. of Rajasthan, Govt. of India and CCIM, New Delhi.

### 2.1. Reservations, Subjects and Admission Capacity in NIA, Jaipur.

Admission will be given by the counselling board on 50 percent seats reserved for candidates of Rajasthan domicile and seats for in-service quota for Rajasthan and other states as per seat matrix.

#### **Note for Orthopaedic Physically Handicapped PH Seat as per Seat Matrix:**

- i. Candidate must possess a valid document certifying his/her physical disability conforming to judgement of Supreme Court of India i.e. with the approval of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India vide letter no.18018/ 2/ 2009-ME (P-1) dated 17.02.2009 it has been decided that while providing reservation in admission to medical course in the first instance candidates with disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% shall be considered and in case candidates are not available of such candidates in that category then the candidates with disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% will also be considered for admission subject to the outcome in the Writ Petition (Civil) 184/2005-Dr. Kumar Sourav Vs. UOI & others is pending in the Supreme Court of India.
- ii. The disability certificate should be produced by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions.

**Reservation:-** Provision of reservation for graduates of Universities of Rajasthan will be in accordance of rules and regulations enforced by Govt. of Rajasthan and concerned university.

**2.5 Admission in the PG Courses of AYUSH Colleges in Rajasthan shall be available subject to approval by CCIM and Ministry of AYUSH Govt. of India, Govt. of Rajasthan and Affiliating University concerned.**

### 2.6 Character/Conduct

Candidates should bring the Character/Conduct Certificate in the prescribed form at the time of Counselling/interview. Admission of candidate whose character has not been found satisfactory during the degree course is liable to be rejected.

1. **In-Service Candidates of Central / State Government** who seek admission against the seats reserved for the said category must submit No Objection Certificate by the Competent Authority to the Office of the Chairman, AYUSH UG/PG Admission Counselling Board, Dr. SR Rajasthan Ayurved University Campus, Jodhpur at the time of counselling otherwise the Candidate will not be considered for In-service Category and instead he/she will be considered for unreserved Category only.

**Note: - In case the Central / State Govt. do not nominate candidates:-**

**i In case the Central Govt. do not nominate candidates by the date specified the Board will fill up the seats by the candidates in the waiting list sponsored by the deficient States/UTS and in accordance with marks obtained by them in the AIPGET-2019 as per guideline of AYUSH Dept.**

**ii. Deficient state candidate must have produced their deficient state proof (Forwarding letter of their state), one day prior to Ist counselling otherwise the candidate shall not be considered for the specific category.**

**iii In case the State Govt. do not nominate Candidate by the date Specified seat shall be treated vacant for University College of Ayurveda, Jodhpur & MMM Govt. Ayurved College, Udaipur. These vacant seats will be filled as per norms.**

2. Candidates should clearly mention the Category (In-Service-General, In- Service- SC, In-Service-ST, In-Service-OBC General, SC, ST, OBC, PH) in the column Provided under which he/she seeks admission.
3. In the absence of proof of belonging to SC, ST, OBC, PH, In-Service etc. such candidates will be treated as unreserved Category candidates.

### 2.7 Miscellaneous:

**i.** The preference given by the candidate with respect to institute/subject at the time of submission of Form/Counselling will be final & no change will be allowed subsequently.

**ii.** The Admission Form will be considered for the MD/MS (Ay.) Part-I only for the Session and Year the candidate applies for.

**iii.** Admission will be granted subject to being declared Medically Fit by a duly Constituted Body by the concerned Institute.

**iv.** The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any Application Form or to amend any rule and regulation or cancel any admission without assigning any reason thereof.

**v.** A candidate without Original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission at the allotted college under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in PG course and has deposited his / her certificates in any college/ institute / university and comes for counselling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the another college / institute / university, will also be allowed to take admission at the allotted college subject to production of ORIGINAL certificate issued by concerned Counselling Board / Head of the institution to this Counselling Board during his/her counselling, stating that the original documents of the candidate are deposited with them.

- vi. The original documents of the admitted candidates will remain with the Counselling Board/ Institute till completion of the Course.
- vii. Any dispute will be subject to Jodhpur Jurisdiction only.

## 3. GENERAL INFORMATION IN CONTEXT OF P.G.

**3.1 Aim of the Post-Graduate Course:** The aim of the Post-Graduate course shall be to provide proper training to the students and make them competent Teachers, Research Workers and specialists in the respective subject.

**P.G. Education:** The University conducts PG Education as per CCIM rules for the award of PG Degree in Ayurveda Vachaspati / Dhanvatari (MD/MS(Ay.) in the following 14 specialities.

**3.2 Duration of the Course:** The Course Study for the Post-Graduate Degree of Ayurveda Vachaspati / Dhanvatari (MD/MS(Ay.) (.....Subject concerned) is of three years duration having two Examinations as follows:

(1) Part-I (Preliminary) Examination will be conducted at the end of one academic year after admission.

(2) Part-II (Final) Examination will be conducted at the end of two academic years after completing Part-I Course. No Candidate shall be relieved before the completion of the Course under any circumstance. If at all a scholar wishes to leave the course, he will have to refund the entire Stipend received from the Institute. The candidate has to submit the Thesis six month before completion of his study tenure. In case the candidate fails to submit the same within the Stipulated period, he/she will not be allowed to appear in the final examination.

**3.3 Method of Training:** The Scholars admitted will be given intensive training in classical knowledge along with comparative and critical study of the subject. They are required to know about the methods and techniques of research work done in the respective fields and take part in various seminars, group discussions, clinical meetings etc. The Scholars are also required to participate in the teaching and training program for under- graduate students or interns in their



subjects. They will also have to attend the hospital duties assigned to them during all the three years.

**3.4 Medium of Training:** Hindi / English shall be the medium for the Post- Graduate Training and Thesis in Ayurveda. The Question Papers will be set in Hindi/English and the candidates can answer in Hindi/English.

**3.5 Stipend:** As per rules existing in different colleges.

- (i) The Stipend is payable only after verification of attendance and on the recommendation of the HoD on the satisfactory progress of the scholar.
- (ii) Scholars who have already passed / appeared in MD/MS(Ay.) examination in any branch/specialty or appeared in MD/MS(Ay.) Part-II Examination will not be paid any Stipend.
- (iii) The scholars will not be allowed to practice or do any type of job outside the Institute during the duration of the PG Course.
- (iv) Every scholar, on admission, will have to execute a Bond on a Non- Judicial Stamp of Rs. 100/- undertaking to abide to study and complete the Course and if his admission is cancelled by the University before completion for any reason, he/she will return the amount of Stipend received by him / her from the Institute.
